

Project Narrative

This project is a cooperative effort including Cass Soil and Water Conservation District, the Association of Cass County Lakes (ACCL), and registered Homeowner Associations throughout Cass County. All of Cass Counties 514 lakes and streams eventually drain into the Upper Mississippi Watershed. Sediment and nutrient pollution continue to be a primary concern when addressing water quality protection issues.



This project will allow the numerous partners to address their own unique water quality issues, many of which have identified problems but lack the financial ability to complete projects on their own. By providing matching subgrants to implement conservation practices to reduce stormwater runoff and retain water on the land, this project aims to reduce the movement of sediment and nutrients throughout the county.
