PUBLIC DRAINAGE DITCH BUFFER STRIP REPORTING CALENDAR YEAR 2010 SUMMARY

Beginning with calendar year 2008, BWSR began to collect buffer strip reporting data from Minnesota Statutes Chapter 103E drainage authorities, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Section 103E.067 Ditch Buffer Strip Annual Reporting, which was enacted in 2007. This document summarizes the buffer strip reporting data for calendar year 2010.

On April 1, 2011, BWSR notified Chapter 103E drainage authorities of the annual buffer strip reporting requirements in Section 103E.067 and provided a form to document the requested information for calendar year 2010. This notification was sent via email using a drainage authority point-of-contact list developed from the Public Drainage Ditch Buffer Study, February 2006 and subsequently updated during annual buffer strip reporting. The following buffer strip reporting information was requested:

- 1) For calendar year 2010, please fill in the number of actions for which viewers were appointed for each of the categories below. Also include the number of miles of buffer strip established in accordance with Section 103E.021 under each of the categories:
 - a) 103E.212 New drainage system projects. (establishment)
 - b) 103E.215 Improvement of drainage system.
 - c) 103E.221 Improvement of outlets.
 - d) 103E.351 Redetermination of benefits and damages.
 - e) 103E.715 Repair by petition., Subd. 6. Repair by resloping ditches, leveling waste banks, installing erosion control, and removing trees.

- 3) Please provide the number of violations of section 103E.021 identified.
- 4) For each of the violations in (3), identify the enforcement action(s) taken.
