Grant Description

Septic Treatment Systems Incentive grants are awarded through a competitive application process hosted by MPCA. The funds are awarded based on whether a county: requires compliance inspections for point of sale/property transfer or inspections with permit applications; has a plan to improve compliance (e.g. a records catalog or inventory); or is implementing a plan based on past compliance inventory or records catalog work.
