Regulatory In-lieu fee and Bank Information Tracking System

WELCOME TO RIBITS Wetland Banking Online

In cooperation with BWSR, the Corps has developed an internet-based bank tracking system that provides electronic record-keeping and file-sharing for regulators and bankers. Using Google Earth imaging, the system shows bank footprints and watershed service areas. The Corps has mandated use of RIBITS by all districts across the nation. BWSR is helping the Corps set up and maintain RIBITS for Minnesota banks.

RIBITS will serve as the location to upload and download application materials, Technical Evaluation Panel findings, approval information, monitoring reports, photographs, credit allocation requests, agency comments and communications, and easement and compliance inspections. All TEP members involved in wetland bank site review, approval, and oversight will need to learn how to use the RIBITS system.
